

Career Ready is a senior school pathway designed to provide students with an alternative model of education that focuses on career exploration and transferrable skills across a range of industries. Career Ready aligns with Tec-NQ's core vision to create employability and success through industry skills, experience and support.

Career Ready allows students to complete their Queensland Certificate of Education whilst introducing them to the expectations and diversity found in the workplace. Year 11 is based on transferable skills designed to enable students to recognise their career aspirations and support career planning and goal setting. The skills and knowledge learned in Year 11 sets the foundation for students to pursue career specific pathways in Year 12.

Students who meet Tec-NQ's Earn the Right to Work criteria gain industry team support in participating in up to 33 weeks of work placement across Years 11 and 12.

Career Ready students may choose to participate in a general skills program based on the trades or career specific training based on their interests. The learning environment at Tec-NQ enables students to develop as individuals in a friendly and supportive atmosphere, and provide practical skills to turn a passion in a career.
